


# THOSE WHO DEDICATE THEIR LIFE TO THE CAUSE OF HUMANITY BECOME IMMORTAL



Padma Shri, Rai Bahadur (Late) Dr. Mathra Dass Pahwa (1880-1972) was a world famous Eye Surgeon who used to perform eye operations free of cost for the poor and the down trodden and for this generosity, he was widely known as the Messiah of the have-nots. Due to his invaluable services in this field, he brought Moga on the map of the world. He conducted over half a million surgeries during his life time, continuing to operate till the age of 92. He also created a record by conducting 750 operations in a single day. Throughout his illustrious career as an eminent Eye Surgeon of India, he was also recognised and acclaimed as Netra-Dev (The God of Eyes).

He was honoured with many commendable awards including the title of Rai Sahib (1919), the title of Rai Bahadur (1924), Kesari Hind Gold Medal (1924) and the prestigious Padam Shri (1954) for his invaluable and indispensable service to humanity. Rai Bahadur Dr. Mathra Dass Pahwa established D.M. College, Moga in the sacred memory of Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati in June 1926. The name of this Eye Wizard will always be worshipped by the coming generations because of his humanitarianism, benevolence and magnanimity.

- 4. Student having Compartment in one subject in B.A/B.SC.III Examination must obtain at least 45% marks in the subject of Post-graduation will be admitted provisionally. If such a student fails to clear the compartment in the next two chances, then his provisional admission to M.A. 1 shall be considered as cancelled because fulfilling the eligibility conditions laid down by Panjab University Chandigarh is mandatory for each student.

## Eligibility For Admission To M. A. II

Admission to M.A.II shall be open to student who has

- 1. Passed in M.A.I or placed under Compartment by Panjab University Chandigarh.
- 2. Students who have passed M.A.I from Kurukshetra University/ Maharishi Dayanand University/ Punjabi University/ Guru Nanak Dev University/ Himachal Pradesh University are eligible.

## **Eligibility For Admission To M.Sc. (Mathematics)**

Admission is open to candidates having Bachelor's Degree in Science **or Arts with Maths** with 50% marks in the aggregate or with 45% marks in the subject of Mathematics. There will be four semesters, Each semester having five theory papers.

## PGDCA POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN COMPUTER APPLICATIONS

The duration of the said Diploma will be of one year having two semesters. This course is ideal for the students with no previous knowledge of Computer. It will give them an understanding of the basic concepts of Computer along with other skills which enable them to enter into IT industry.

Eligibility: Graduation in any stream with 50% marks in aggregate.

## Career Oriented/ Add-On Courses (to be Opted in 2nd Semester of Ist year level only)

The University Grants Commission under the modern scenario of globalization of education and economy has reoriented and reformed its policies and programmes. Such a step has been undertaken in order to make the current Indian Higher Education System more career oriented. An innovative flexible system of certificate/diploma/ advanced diploma has been introduced. Moreover the college already runs Introduction to Computer Science as an additional subject at 1st Year Level. This would be parallel to conventional B.A/B.Sc/B.Com. degree. The primary objective of the introduction is to make the student market oriented by enhancing those skills which have practical utility for jobs. The college has offered three Add-on-Courses for students at 1st year level. The college will only start the course if the number of students opting the course is **atleast 20.** The career oriented courses for to the undergraduate student are as under:

1. Computer Based Accounting

2. Fashion Designing

3. Insurance Business

## Assessment Process

The college has House Examination Board which conducts Mid Semester Examinations during each semester. There will be one Mid Semester Examination for the students appearing in each semester.

Mid Semester Test-I : MST for 1st, 3rd & 5th semester will be held in the month of September/October.

Mid Semester Test-II : MST for 2nd, 4th & 6th semester will be held in the month of March/April

- 1. No student will be allowed to appear in the Mid Semester Examination without Identity Card.
- 2. Appearing in the Mid Semester Examination is mandatory for each student for the purpose of Internal Assessment as per P.U. guidelines.
- 3. Absence or Exemption from the House Examination/Mid Semester Examination is not allowed on any ground. Absent students will be awarded as Zero in that paper/s. However, such a student will be given another chance to appear in the Special Test with the prior permission of the Principal. The student will have to pay the fine of Rs. 100/- per paper before appearing in the Special Test.
- 4. If a student fails to get the minimum percentage of marks (aggregate) in Mid Semester Examination as per P.U. guidelines, such a student will have to reappear in the Special Test in all the papers with the prior permission of the Principal. The student will have to pay the fine of Rs. 100/- per paper before appearing in the Special Test.

## Eligibility Conditions for appearing in the P.U. Examinations

The examination form of a student admitted to the college will be sent provisionally for each semester subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- 1. He/She is required to show good conduct during the course of his/her stay as a bonafide student of the college
- 2. He/She is required to attend at least 75% of lectures delivered in each subject both in the theory as well as in the practical examination. The lectures are to be counted from the day of commencement of teaching of the classes up to the last day of the session, when the classes are dispersed by the Principal for the preparatory holidays.
- 3. He/She will have to secure at least 25% of marks in aggregate in all the subjects in the college House Examination held during semesters. If he/she fails to fulfil the eligibility conditions of House Examination, laid down by P.U. Chandigarh, he/she will have to reappear in the Special Test with the permission of the Principal.

## **Internal Assessment**

- 1. There are 10% marks for Internal Assessment allotted to each subject at Under-graduate level, out of which 5% weightage will be given to MST, 3% weightage will be given to academic achievements (Seminars, Projects & Assignments) and 2% weightage will be given to attendance.
- 2. There are 20% marks for Internal Assessment allotted to each subject at Post-graduate level. Continuous assessment may include written assignments, snap tests, participation in discussion in the class, term papers and attendance etc.

## **Special Test/ Discretionary Test**

A student who fails to obtain 25% marks in aggregate in House Examinations during each semester, such a student will have to appear in the Special Test with the permission of the Principal. The student will also have to pay the fine of Rs. 100/- per paper before appearing in the Special Test and he/she has to fulfil the eligibility conditions as per Panjab University guidelines.

## Facilities For Overall Personality Development

## NCC (National Cadet Corps)

The college has been granted one (01) NCC Platoon comprising 53 cadets. (33% Gilrs (SW), 67% Boys (SD) The Cadets will be provided the opportunities to participate in additional service training programmes like Republic Day Parade at New Delhi, Basic and Advanced Leadership camps etc. The cadets will also be provided complete NCC kit so that they may follow the NCC protocol on all the occasions. In case of any loss/damage to the NCC uniform & other articles, the concerned cadet will be fined as per NCC guidelines.

## **NSS (National Service Scheme)**

To inculcate the feeling of public welfare, national service and dignity of labour, units of Girls & Boys NSS are established in the college. The students who attend NSS Camps, get special benefit while seeking admission to higher education and jobs.

### **Medical Facilities**

The college provides the facility of a Doctor keeping in view the health of the students and the employees. If a student/employee falls sick or suffers from any medical emergency during the college hours, the college arranges a Doctor to provide first aid.

## **Sports**

The institution lays a special emphasis on the development of the all round personality of the students. ## RULES & REGULATIONS

## College Leave Rules

In case of leave, it must be applied for in advance in the form of application. An application for leave must be countersigned by the student's parent/guardian. No student will be allowed leave for more than 15 days in the session. Leave beyond 15 days will automatically stand cancelled. In case of medical leave, a medical certificate must be submitted to the college office along with the leave application sanctioned by the **Principal.** Once leave is granted by the Principal, its information must be given to the concerned teachers & the student has to submit the application for leave to the college office. If a student remains absent without leave continuously for seven days his/her name will be struck off from the college, and the student will be readmitted with the permission of the Principal along with fine of Rs. 500/- to be submitted in the college office. However, sanctioned leave will not relax the condition of 75% attendance to become eligible for appearing in Panjab University Examination.

## **Identity Card**

Each student is issued identity-cum-library card bearing his/her photograph, name and roll number at the time of admission, All the students are required to carry their Identity Cards with them during their presence on the campus. The defaulters will be fined heavily. If Identity Card is lost, duplicate can be got issued on payment of Rs. 100/- Students are to complete all formalities of Identity Card within seven days of the start of the session.

## Change of Subjects/Faculty

A student is permitted to change his/her subject or faculty with in one month from the commencement of the session with the permission of the Principal.

# Code of Conduct

The students of the college are required to observe the following code conduct both inside and outside the college

- Show proper respect to the teachers and carry out their instructions faithfully.

- Bring the identity card daily and produce it, if any member of the staff or official of the college demands at any time. Identity card may be checked on the entry gate of the college and those found without it shall not be allowed to enter.
- Abide by all rules, regulations and instructions issued by the college from time to time.
- Eve-teasing is not allowed in the college campus at any cost. If any such incident happens, the concerned girl/employee should report the matter in writing along with evidence to the Principal. Strict action will be taken against the accused if the complaint is found genuine after fair investigation by the competent authority/committee constituted by the Principal.
- Punctuality is the sign of good culture. The students should be punctual at all occasions and in attending their classes, functions and fulfilling their duties & responsibilities.

- Utilize vacant periods in reading books, magazines and newspapers available in the library.
- Quarrels and disputes should be avoided. In the event of a dispute, a written complaint should be made to the Principal at once. No one is allowed to take the law in his/her own hands.
- Students should understand that the college property is a national trust and as such its upkeep is as much their responsibility as that of the administration. 

## आर्य समाज के दस नियम

- सब सत्य विद्या और जो पदार्थ विद्या से जाने जाते हैं,
   उन सबका आदि मूल परमेश्वर है ।
- ईश्वर सच्चिदानन्दस्वरूप, निराकार, सर्वशक्तिमान, न्यायकारी, दयालु, अनन्मा, अनन्त, निर्विकार, अनादि, अनुपम, सर्वाधार, सर्वव्यापक, सर्वान्तार्यामी, अनर, अमर, अभय, नित्य, पवित्र और सृष्टिकर्ता है, उसी की उपासना करनी योग्य है ।
- वेद सब सत्य विद्याओं की पुस्तक है । वेद का पढ़ना, पढ़ाना और सुनना-सुनाना सब आर्यों का परम धर्म है ।
- सत्य को ग्रहण करने और असत्य के छोड़ने हेतु सर्वदा उद्यत रहना चाहिए ।
- सब काम धर्मानुसार अर्थात् सत्य और असत्य को विचार करके करने चाहिए ।
- संसार का उपकार करना इस समाज का मुख्य उद्देश्य है अर्थात् शारीरिक, आत्मिक और सामाजिक उन्नति करना ।
- सबसे प्रीतिपूर्वक, धर्मानुसार, यथायोग्य व्यवहार करना चाहिए ।
- अविद्या का नारा और विद्या की वृद्धि करनी चाहिए ।
- प्रत्येक को अपनी उन्नित से सन्तुष्ट न रहना चाहिए किन्तु सबकी उन्निति में अपनी उन्नित सम चाहिए ।
- सब मनुष्यों को सामाजिक सर्विहतकारी नियम पालन में परतंत्र <mark>रहना</mark> चाहिए और प्रत्येक हितकारी नियम में सब स्वतंत्र रहें ।



स्वामी दयानंद सरस्वती जी का जन्म 12 फरवरी टंकारा में सन् 1824 में मोरबी के पास काठियावाड़ क्षेत्र (जिला राजकोट), गुजरात में हुआ था | उनके पिता का नाम कृष्ण जी लाल जी तिवारी और माँ का नाम यशोदा बाई था | आप का असली नाम मूलशंकर था | वे 1846 में सत्य की खोज में निकल पड़े | महर्षि दयानंद के हृदय में आदर्शवाद की उच्च भावना, यथार्थवादी मार्ग अपनाने की सहज प्रवृत्ति, मातृभूमि की नियति को नई दिशा देने का अदम्य उत्साह, धार्मिक – समाजिक – आर्थिक व राजनैतिक दृष्टि से युगानुकूल चिन्तन करने की तीव्र इच्छा तथा आर्यावर्तीय (भारतीय) जनता में गौरवमय अतीत के प्रति निष्ठा जगाने की भावना थी |

उन्होंने 1879 में एक महान् आर्य सुधारक संगठन – आर्य समाज की स्थापना की । आपने सत्यार्थप्रकाश नामक महान ग्रंथ की रचना भी की । वे एक संन्यासी तथा एक महान चिन्तक थे । उन्होंने वेदों की सत्ता को सदा सर्वोपिर माना । स्वामी जी ने कर्म सिद्धांत, पुनर्जन्म, ब्रह्मचर्य तथा संन्यास को अपने दर्शन के चार आधार स्तम्भ बनाए । स्वधर्म, स्वभाषा, स्वराष्ट्र, स्वसंस्कृति ओर स्वदेशोन्नित के अग्रदूत स्वामी दयानन्द जी का शरीर सन् 1883 में दीपावली के दिन पंचतत्व में विलीन हो गए और वे अपने पीछे छोड़ गए एक सिद्धांत, 'कृण्वन्तो विश्वमार्यम्' अर्थात् सारे संसार को श्रेष्ठ मानव बनाओ ।

उनके अन्तिम राष्ट्र थे ''प्रभू ! तूने अच्छी लीला की । आपकी इच्छा पूर्ण हो ।''
